One of my greatest pleasures working in LaMoille is the variety. I have been given the opportunity to teach many different subjects through the years. I have been given the chance to change and grow as the students' needs change and grow. LaMoille has given me many unique teaching opportunities.

Fun Fact:

My first educational position was as an aide in a Mendota summer school program working in a Kindergarten classroom with the children of migrant families when I was in the 8th grade. I continued in that position every summer until I earned my degree, at which time I became the Kindergarten teacher of that same program. Counting those, this would be my 51st year in education. I have been teaching for 43 years in 7 different districts working with students in K, and grades 6-12. I have also been an administrator in 4 of the 7 districts. I was lured to LaMoille in 2002 by Mrs. Cynthia Shevokas because . the district had a need for my special education services.
