Academics Update

Please enjoy the highlights below, as to what is currently unfolding in the classrooms within our school district:

Allen Grade School

- → Beginning Band, with Mr. Kazin, is up and running, with two songs under their belts. The students continue to learn new notes on their instruments, reading music, with appropriate counts and rests, and collectively making music.
- → 1st grade recently completed their annual Butterfly Unit. The students always enjoy watching the butterflies emerge and the experience of releasing them.
- → 4th grade has been working on a STEM project which is not only helping them with their problem solving skills, but also with their teamwork.







→ 2nd Grade has really been working on their Rooted in Reading lessons. The students are being exposed to great stories that are leading to strong vocabulary development and rich discussions.

La Moille Jr./Sr. High School

→ Physical Education with Mrs. Conley and Mr. Kalsto has taken to the court this last week, participating in Volleyball games within the PE class and soaking up the beautiful weather, with exercises outdoors, weather permitting.

- → Students have been participating in Explore classes, through a choice selection of learning on a month by month basis.
- → Students in Chemistry have been participating in scientific labs, documenting chemical reactions at each sequential step throughout the process. Mr. Biederstedt challenges students with hands-on learning and higher level processing.
- → Students in Geometry recently began to create the very first La Moille Mini Putt Putt Golf Course, utilizing measurements and mathematical concepts taught by Mrs. Miller.
- → Driver's Education students have started to "hit the road", focusing on safety first, with instruction led by Mr. Kalsto. Students implement the "rules of the road" while behind the wheel.
- → Vet Science has had a current focus on medicine administration, doses, and measurements. Students participated in labs, learning how to properly count out medications and fill vials to the appropriate ml/cc, with Ms. Johnson leading the way.

TRANSPORTATION SPOTLIGHT

A note on bus safety from our Transportation Coordinator, Mr. Doug Tuntland:

- Always remain at least 10 feet (5 Big Steps) away from a school bus that is moving or not moving except for entering the bus after the driver indicates it is safe. Never walk or stand behind the bus.
- 2. Always sit with your bottom on the bus seat with your entire body behind the seat back in front of you. The seat backs are designed to protect you but can only do their job if you sit properly.
- 3. Always remain seated until the bus comes to a complete stop!
- Always use the handrails when entering or exiting the bus. Secure all loose items such as backpacks and sweatshirt strings so they do not get caught while exiting the bus.
- Always ask the bus driver to help you if you drop items near the bus. Never pick them up yourself as the bus driver will not be able to see you.
- Always remember that if you can not see the bus driver he probably can't see you.
- Always remember that eating is not permitted on a school bus for your safety.
